CARTERTON BELVEDERE BLOCK ROAD RELAYS INFORMATION SHEET

STARTS All open grade relays start at the Belvedere Hall ..
All U/17 Relays start at the Frenshaw Reserve entrance 3.9km into lap..

FINISH All relays finish outside the Belvedere Hall ..

PRE RELAY INFORMATION FROM TEAMS ..all we require is the number of teams you will have in each grade NO names will be required till relay finish..

RACE NUMBERS ..

We will provide race numbers but need to know how many teams your club will have in either relay please make sure pre race information is forwarded.

RUNNERS NAMES ... team managers will be given a team sheet to be filled in and handed in at the finish with hopefully the runners lap times this helps if we have problems with timing and a double check ..

TIMES . the main emphasis on the day will be to turn out team results so the prizegiving can take place straight after the last team finishes.. if time and manpower alloww fastest lap times will be acknowledged at the prizegiving..

AFTERNOON TEA .. will be available at the hall with tea, coffee and biscuits other food and drinks will be fer sale at the same venue ..

TOILETS .. Men and womens at the Hall ..

RACE RULES ... will be the same as used for all road races in the Wellington region . keep to the RIGHT HAND side of the road at all times .. Obey the instructions of all race officials . . Runners are requested not to warm up in front of the change over as this can cause problems for the timekeepers ..

BATONS ... all teams will be given a baton which must be carried in the hand at all times, there will be a five metre change zone ...

PARKING .. this may be a problem we will try and get the use of a paddock close to the hall but this will depend on the weather .. PLEASE do not block driveways..

RUBBISH .. please pick up any rubbish as the locals get a bit annoyed about this..

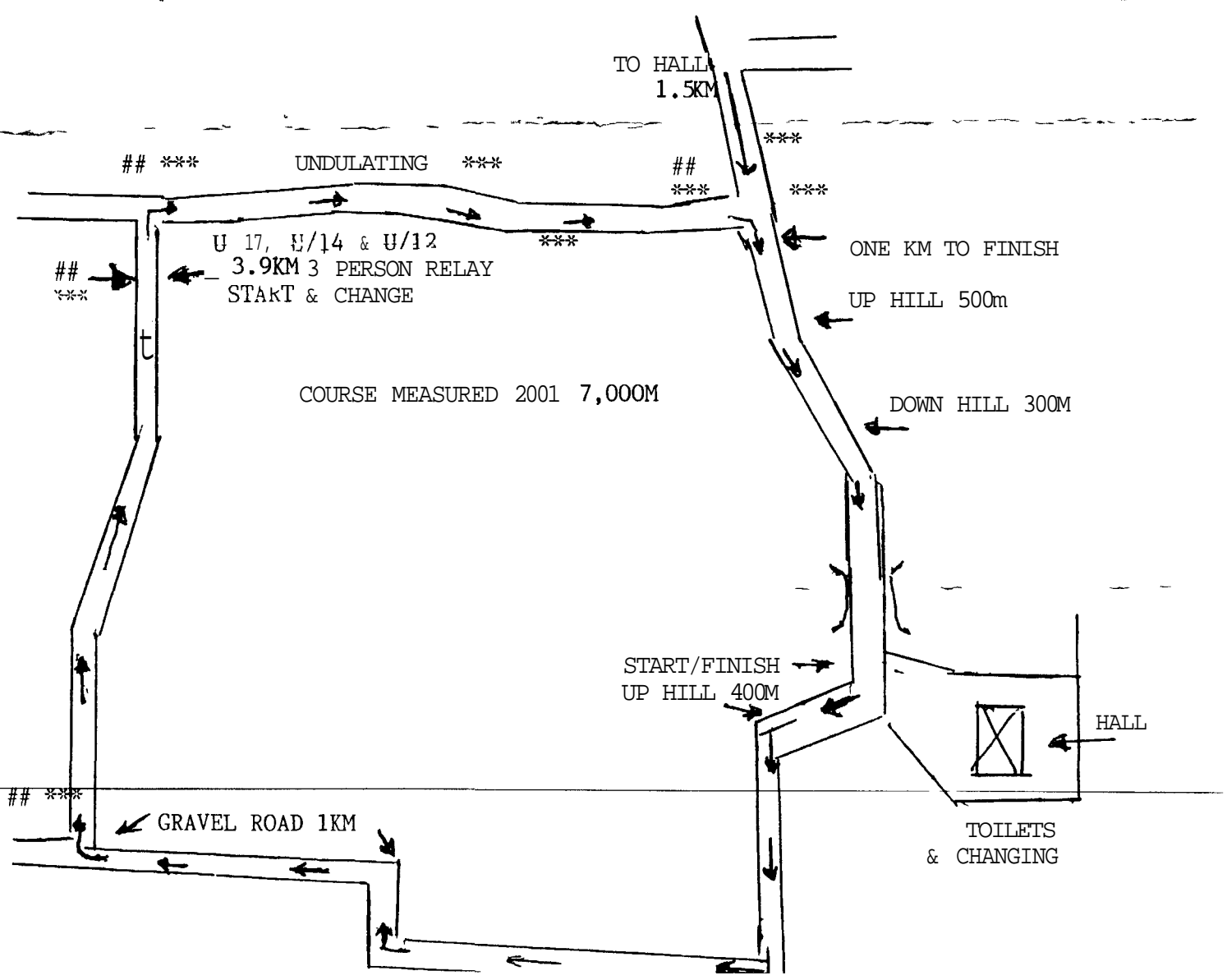
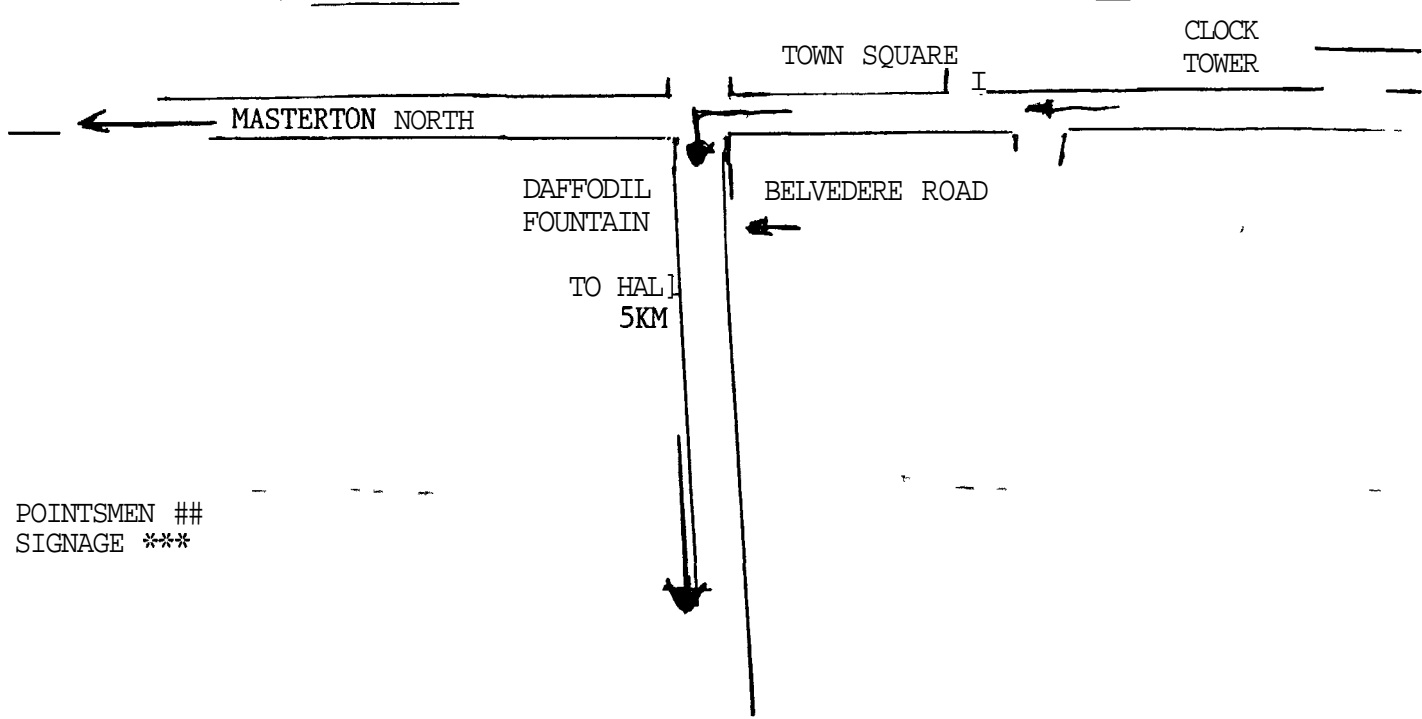
Regardless of the numbers entered or the weather the relays will be held their future depends on your support ..
